Monarchs earn top honors in Yale tournament

The Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) delegation harvested a total of 106 medals - 66 golds and 43 silvers - and 1 trophy at the World Scholar's Cup Tournament of Champions held in Yale University's New Haven, Connecticut campus last November 13 to 23, 2018. The prestigious competition pitted them against close to 2,300 students from 58 countries in Team Debate, Collaborative Writing, a test known as the Scholar's Challenge, and the quiz-bee style Scholar's Bowl.

Winning gold medals in the individual debate were Nicholas James Gonzales, Robert Constantine Rivera, Renz Leobert Del Rosario, Rance Gabriel Llovido, Akisha Julianne Cu and Jasmine Reeves while getting a silver were Hyuk Jin Park, Matthew Ezekiel Sybingco, Miguel Dominico Alzona, David Jacob Ramos and Syna Vastardis. In the team debate, the gold medalists were Miguel Dominico Alzona, Nicholas James Gonzales, Syna Vastardis, Jasmine Reeves, Renz Leobert Del Rosario, Gabrielle Anindito, Rance Gabriel Llovido, David Jacob Ramos, Cuitlauzina Brianna Cerbito, Robert Constantine Rivera, Akisha Julianne Cu and Matthew Ezekiel Sybingco.

In the Scholar's Bowl, Robert Constantine Rivera, Akisha Julianne Cu, Matthew Ezekiel Sybingco, Jasmine Reeves, Renz Leobert Del Rosario and Gabrielle Anindito secured the gold while Geoffrey Eliezer Borabien, Princess Mei Aguilar, Paul Andrew Tatad, Miguel Dominico Alzona, Nicholas James Gonzales, Syna Vastardis, Rance Gabriel Llovido, David Jacob Ramos, Cuitlauzina Brianna Cerbito, Mikhail Astin Alzona, Hyuk Jin Park and Io Carpiso snagged the silver.

In Collaborative Writing for individuals, the gold medal winners were Mikhail Astin Alzona and Miguel Dominico Alzona while the silver medalists were Akisha Julianne Cu, Matthew Ezekiel Sybingco and Cuitlauzina Brianna Cerbito. In the team event, landing the silver were Robert Constantine Rivera, Akisha Julianne Cu and Matthew Ezekiel Sybingco.

Bringing home a trophy was Miguel Dominico Alzona for being the Top Scholar from the Philippines while joining him in the Top 100 Champion Scholars were Cuitlauzina Brianna Cerbito,
