She will succeed Dr. Marl V. Fernal who has announced his intent to retire after serving a 19-year tenure as chief executive.

Before her newest appointment, Tizon has served as Executive Vice President and Vice President for Administration of SISC responsible for the effective and efficient management and delivery of administrative programs and services that support the academic endeavors. Recognized for her work in training and development, education and learning, and campus administration, she has served as Executive Director of the Asian Association of School Human Resource Management and Development Practitioners, Inc since 1999.

Students from SISC were named recipients of top certificates in the 2018 International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) - Mathematics Assessment conducted by Educational Assessment Australia. The competition is participated in by more than twenty countries from Asia, Africa, Europe, and America.

The ICAS - Mathematics Assessment tests the participants' skills and knowledge in algebra and patterns, data and statistics, measures and units, number and arithmetic, and space and geometry. The SISC awardees won for their performance relative to other students worldwide of the same year level.

4. You will be redirected to your default browser with the login page of MOODLE. Press the “Google+” button.

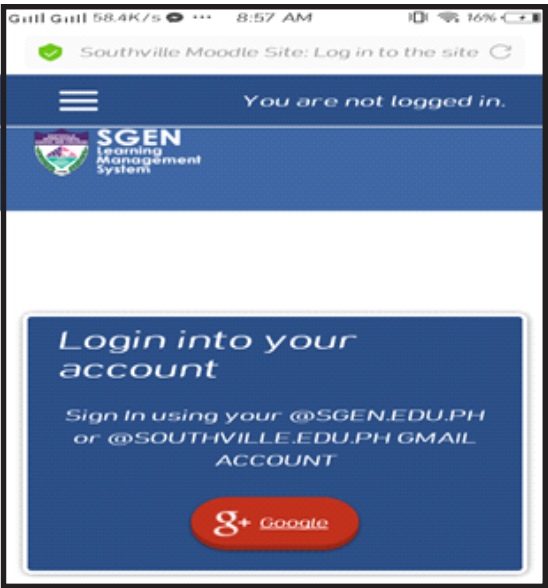
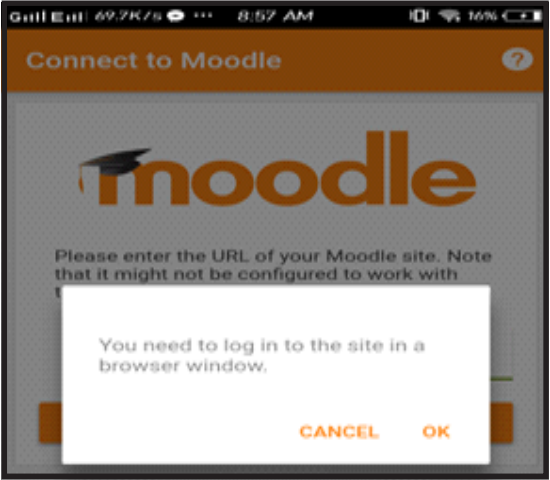

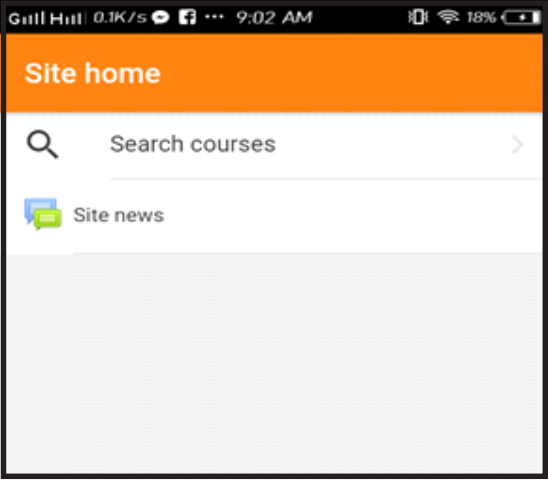
3. Press the connect button. You will then be ask to login to a browser window. Press the “OK” button.
