## **SISC math wizards extend winning streak**

Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) mathletes continued their winning ways at international math competitions by bringing home medals from Singapore and South Africa.

Juan Alfonso Lobien of Gr. 6 - Perseverance was awarded a bronze medal in the 15th International Mathematics Contest held in Singapore last August 2 - 5, 2019. Lobien was part of the Philippine delegation that competed against contestants from 14 other countries and territories namely Australia, Bulgaria, China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Iran, Malaysia, Mexico, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Also getting a bronze medal was Ervin Joshua Bautista of Gr. 7 - Resilience who was part of the Philippine team to the 2019 South Africa International Mathematics Competition held in Durban City last August 1 - 7, 2019. Bautista likewise received a 2nd runner-up trophy in the team contest joined by 500 participants from Australia, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Cyprus, Ghana, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Macau, Malaysia, Mexico, Nepal, Philippines, Romania, South Africa, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Tajikistan, Thailand, Tunisia, United States, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, and Zimbabwe

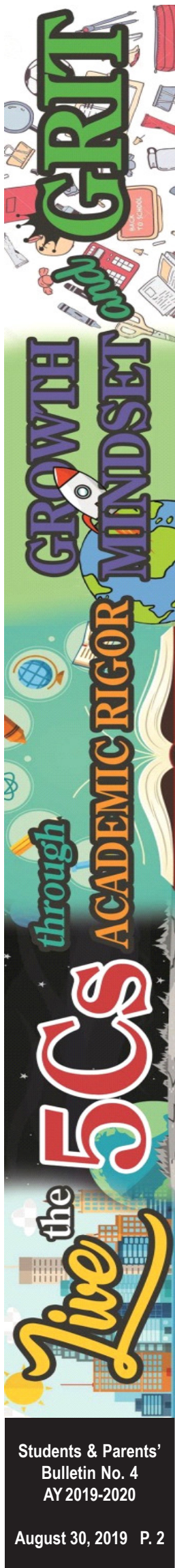

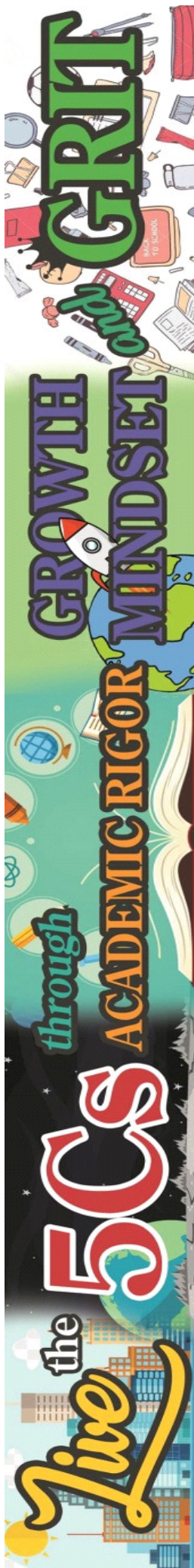
