Monarchs earn top honors in Yale tournament

The Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) delegation harvested a total of 175 medals - 83 golds and 92 silvers - at the World Scholar's Cup Tournament of Champions held in Yale University's New Haven, Connecticut last November 8 to 13, 2019. The prestigious competition pitted them against close to 2000 students from 60 countries in Team Debate, Collaborative Writing, a multiple choice test known as the Scholar's Challenge, and the quiz-bee style Scholar's Bowl.

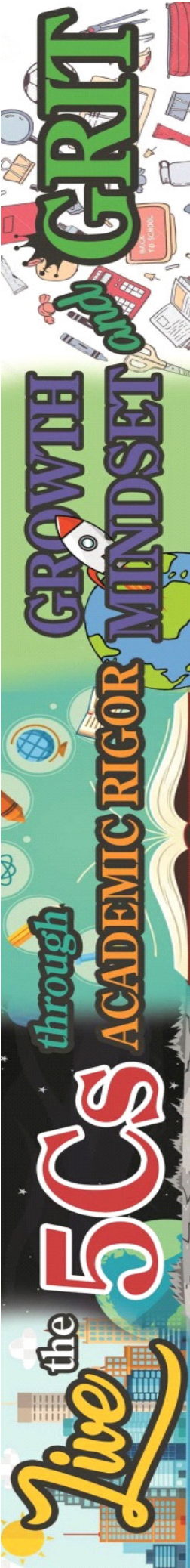
