## Monarchs receive national recognition

Six students from Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) will be awarded by the Science Education Institute (SEI) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) in recognition of their achievements in international Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) competitions held this academic year. Railey Emmanuel Ascaño of Gr. 5 - Righteousness, Juan Alfonso Lobien and Kristner Sheyn Saludo of Gr. 6 - Perseverance, Ervin Joshua Bautista of Gr. 7 - Resilience, and Beatriz Lucia Rodriguez and Gwyneth Margaux Tangog of Grade 9 - Commitment will be awarded on April 7, 2020 at the Philippine International Convention Center in Pasay City.

The award will be conferred to students who won gold, silver and/or bronze medals in international competitions at the elementary, secondary and collegiate levels. It is given by DOST-SEI to further motivate the youth to strive for excellence in the fields of science and mathematics, and get into science and technology courses to become part of the country's pool of scientists and engineers.

## Reserve for Academic Year 2020 - 2021

Preschool, Grade School, and High School students who have fully paid their accounts, have no academic deficiency, and have no discipline issues can reserve a slot for academic year 2020 - 2021.

### A. EARLY ENROLLMENT

There will be an early enrollment discount for students, both current and new, who will enroll from April 1 to May 30, 2020.

### B. SOUTHVILLE ALUMNI DISCOUNT

a. Dependents of alumni who will be enrolling at SISC will enjoy 12% discount on the tuition fee of the regular rate of Academic Year 2020-2021 for the first year of enrollment and 5 % on TF for succeeding levels.

b. Alumni who wish to pursue their graduate studies (MBA, MIT, MA Psychology) at SISC will enjoy a discount of 20% on tuition fee for one term and 10% on the subsequent terms.

**C. Entry Level Discount for Grades 1, 7, 11, IB 1 and College.** Entry level discounts apply to SISC graduates who

are enrolling in entry levels following the matrix below:

Incoming Levels	SISC Graduates
Grade 1	10% on the tuition fee only
Grade 7	10% on the tuition fee only
Grade 11	10% on the tuition fee only
IB 1	US\$300.00 discount on the tuition fee only
First Year College	20% on the tuition fee only of the first semester

**D. IB Development Fee is waived for SISC students.**
