Mathletes advance to next round

All the contestants of Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) from Grades 3 - 10 hurdled the elimination round of the 2020 Metrobank - MTAP (Math Teachers'Association of the Philippines) - Department of Education Math Challenge Qualifier to advance to the Division Oral Finals. Nine of them were named Honor Awardees for ranking at the top of their levels.

Gwyneth Margaux Tangog of Gr. 10 - Commitment garnered a perfect score of 50 points for First Honor while Kristner Sheyn Saludo of Gr. 6 - Perseverance got 90% of his answers correct to get the same honor. They both received the Merit Certificate and qualified for the Regional Individual Finals.

Juan Alfonso Lobien of Gr. 6 - Perseverance, Ervin Joshua Bautista of Gr. 7 - Resilience, and Song Hyun Kyu of Gr. 8 -Integrity received Second Honors for getting 80% correct answers. Railey Emmanuell Ascaño of Gr. 5 - Righteousness, Hua Fei Tan and Rymmel Macapagal of Gr. 4 - Humility , and Beatriz Lucia Rodriguez of Gr. 10 - Commitment, on the other hand, get 70% correct answers for Third Honors.

Parenting Corner

Creating a safe prom night

Teens look forward to their prom for a night of style, socializing, and unbridled fun. But behind the glitz and glamour are risks that have long been associated with prom nights. The following tips may ease your prom anxieties, while helping to keep your kids as safe as possible

- 1. Know the plan. Tell your children that you want them to have a wonderful, memorable prom. Keep that wish as a central focus. They need to give you their complete itinerary for the evening, including who they will be with, where they'll be going after the prom and the phone numbers where you can contact them. "We'll just be driving around" is not an acceptable response. Come to a fair decision on a curfew, based upon your children's past level of responsibility in this area. Reinforce your belief in their character and in their ability to act responsibly.
- 2. Stay informed and keep in touch. If your children are not returning home right after the prom, you need to be able to contact them at all times until they return home. You also need to be reachable at all times as well. There can be no doubt where your kids will be and with whom throughout the evening and morning. If they're going to other kids' houses after the prom, check ahead of time with these children's parents. Establish a couple of mandatory call-in times with your kids.
- Offer your support. Give your children the 3. unconditional option of calling you at any time for help or advice. That includes picking them up at any time of day or night, with a promise not to shame or humiliate them in front of others. Assure them that you always welcome being part of their making smart and safe decisions. This unconditional offer of help and advice should be an outstanding offer throughout their lives.
