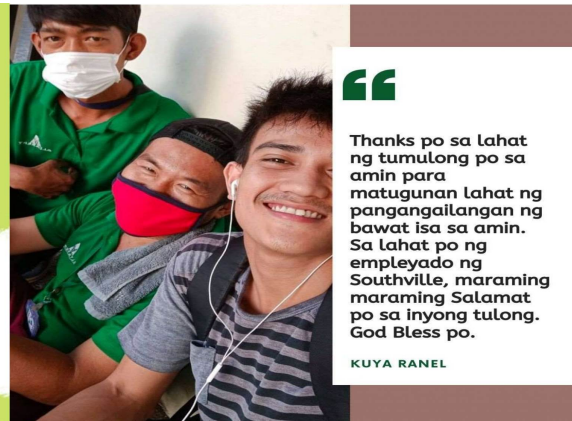
SISC holds donation drive for contractual staff (ates and kuyas of our Monarchs)

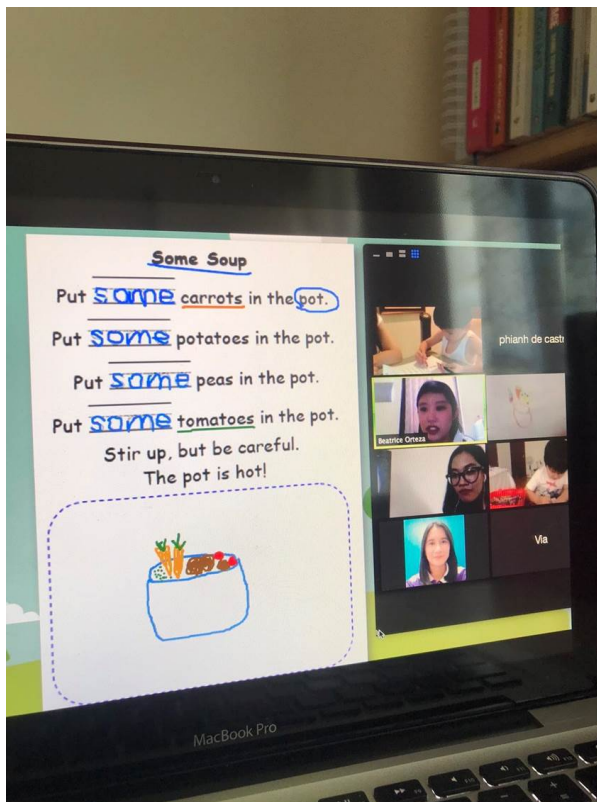
