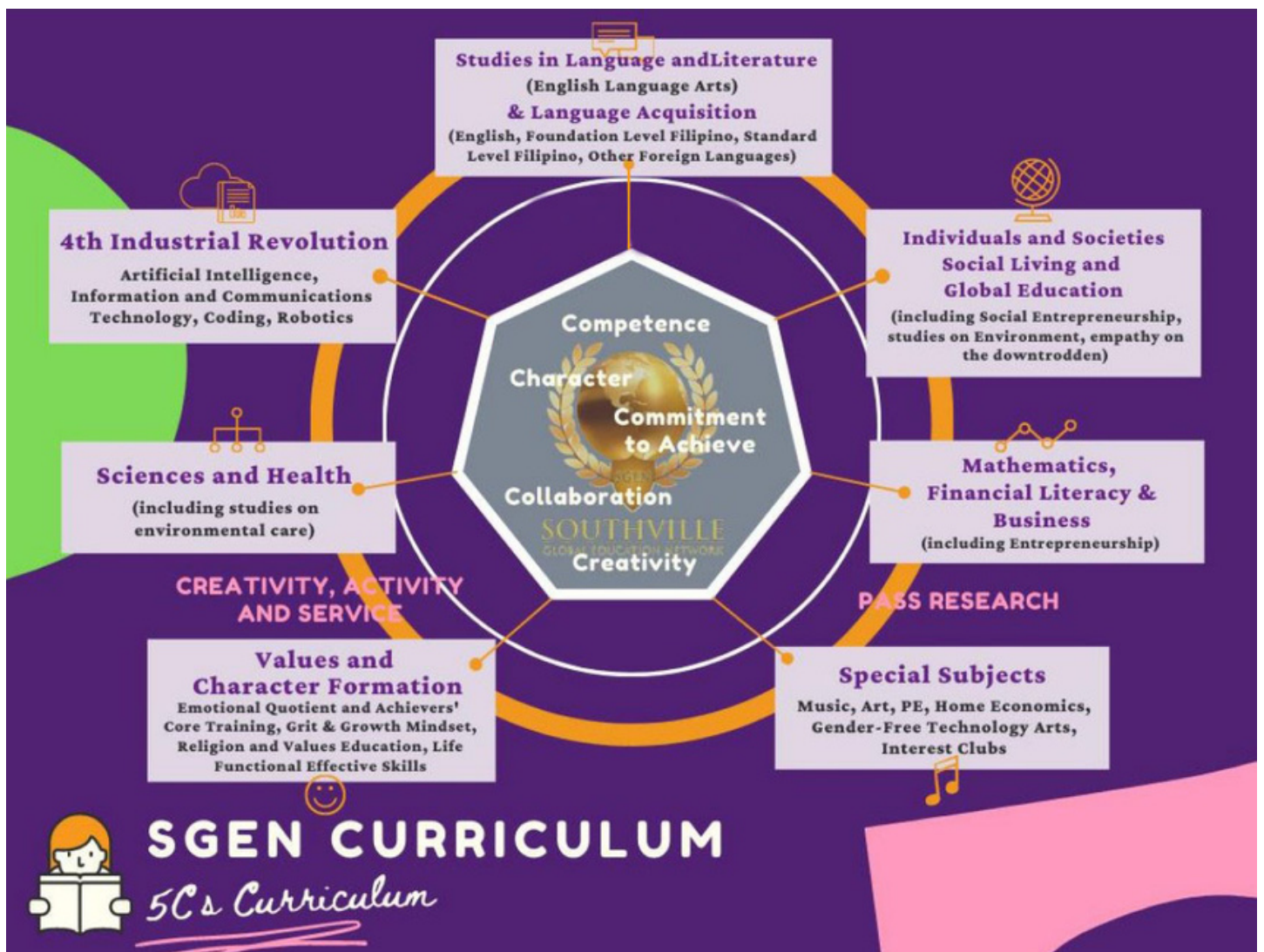

## SISC EMPHASIZES 21st CENTURY SKILLS IN THE 5Cs CURRICULUM



The last several months have brought to light many challenges and opportunities in education, and Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) took it as an opportunity to rethink on how to make learning more engaging and at the same time, rigorous. The school's Virtual Online Learning and Teaching (VOLT) program was implemented to make distance learning more authentic, more relevant to the real world, and more learner-centered.

For the Second Term, the focus is to provide a highly engaging variety of experiences consistent with the SISC's Schoolwide Learner Outcomes or SLOs. The Action Plans include:

1. The 7 Curriculum Groups will be retained and offered namely:

- a. Studies in Language and Literature & Language Acquisition
- b. Mathematics, Financial Literacy & Business
- c. Sciences and Health
- d. Individual and Societies Social Living and Global Education (SLGE)
- e. Values and Character Formation
- f. Special Subjects
- g. 4th Industrial Revolution

2. Tech Arts offered in High School will be more on life skills like plumbing, basic carpentry and basic automotive. There will be no project making but the dignity and importance of vocational education, skills and training will be emphasized.

3. Non-core subjects will be offered on a per term basis to ensure a more focused and rigorous curriculum with the number of units allotted for them for the whole school year still the same.

4. The Emotional Quotient/Achievers Core Training (EQ/ACT) and Leadership Curriculum will be enhanced. SLGE will focus on the skills of the leader while EQ/ACT will focus on the heart and 7Ds of a leader.

## MATHLETES WIN BIG IN INTERNATIONAL MATH CONTEST

SISC math wizards continued their winning streak in international competitions, this time winning 52 awards at a math competition hosted by Thailand. Students from Grade School to High School won 3 gold, 9 silver and 13 bronze medals, and 27 merit and participation awards in the 2020 Thailand International Mathematical Olympiad (TIMO) - Heat Round. SISC was also named Top Performing School and Outstanding School in the online event.

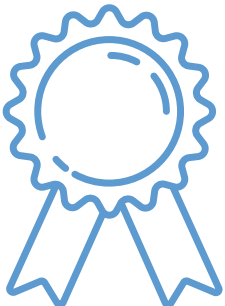

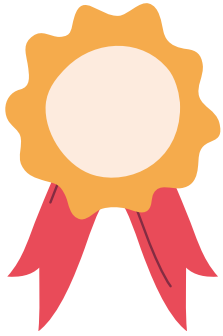

# GUIDELINES ON SUSPENSION OF ONLINE CLASSES

With the typhoon season upon us, here are the guidelines that SISC adheres to:

<b>Typhoon Signal</b>	<b>No Classes</b>
Signal No. 1	Preschool
Signal No. 2	Preschool, Grade School, High School & IB 1 and 2
Signal No. 3	Preschool, Grade School, High School, IB 1 and 2 & College

Depending on signal numbers declared at 10:00 p.m. the day before and 4:30 a.m. of that day, online classes in appropriate levels for the whole day are deemed automatically cancelled/suspended.

In the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA, localized cancellation/suspension of classes is implemented by local chief executives in their capacity as chairpersons of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management. SISC follows this announcement (Parañaque for STAR Campus; Las Piñas for Munich, Luxembourg, and Tropical campuses) for the general safety of the students under our care.
