



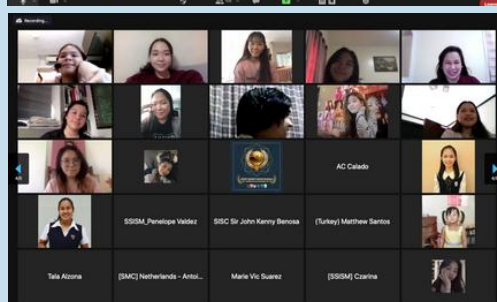
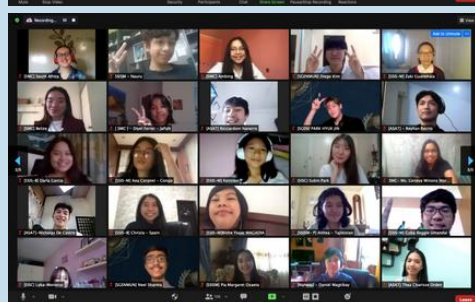
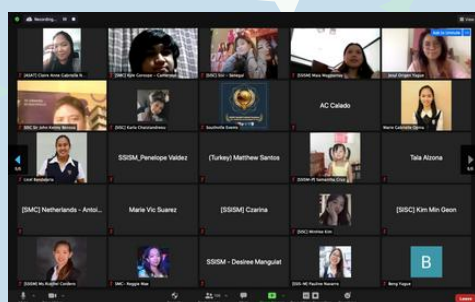

SISC STUDENTS HOST ONLINE MODEL UN SESSIONS



Students from Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) organized their own Model United Nations (MUN) Pre-Conference last November 21 - 22, 2020. The conference was attended by student delegates from Southville Global Education Network (SGEN) and held online, something that was attempted for the first time by the student organizers.

Students from South Mansfield College, Asian SEED Academy of Technology, Stonyhurst Southville International School – Batangas and Stonyhurst Southville International School – Malarayat joined their SISC counterparts in representing a country and solving international problems through debates, negotiations, resolutions and voting. MUN serves as a simulation of the works of the United Nations and is a mainstay of SGEN's extra-curricular program.

While many MUN conferences were cancelled because of the pandemic, disappointing thousands of student delegates around the world, the SISC MUN ambassadors used digital platforms to recreate the “traditional” Model United Nations experience. It speaks of their esprit des corps that in a time of unprecedented academic disruption, they could galvanize and innovate to learn about diplomacy and international relations.

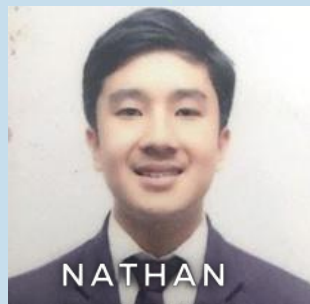

Passwords should be at least 12 characters containing upper- and lower- case letters, numbers, and, if possible, symbols.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Stay alert during online classes, especially when sharing videos, photos, and files.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Use customized backgrounds to avoid accidental disclosure of personal information.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Install and regularly update an anti-virus program.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Mute the microphone and turn off the camera by default, especially when not speaking or reciting, subject to applicable school guidelines on keeping cameras open for the proper conduct of synchronous online classes, where necessary and reasonable, and always with due consideration of privacy principles.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div> <p>Turn off the microphone and camera when leaving one's station for, say, bathroom breaks.</p> </div> </div>	<div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Do not connect phones, laptops, and other gadgets to free or public Wi-Fi networks. (In unavoidable circumstances ensure that the public network has a password and is not accessible to everyone).</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Do not share submissions for an unlimited time. (When the content no longer needs to be shared, delete it).</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Do not send assignments, projects and other requirements to teachers via social media.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Do not take screenshots of the video feed of teachers and classmates.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center; margin-bottom: 10px;">  <div> <p>Do not spam the chat.</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div> <p>Do not give online links and passwords to people who should not be in the class.</p> </div> </div>



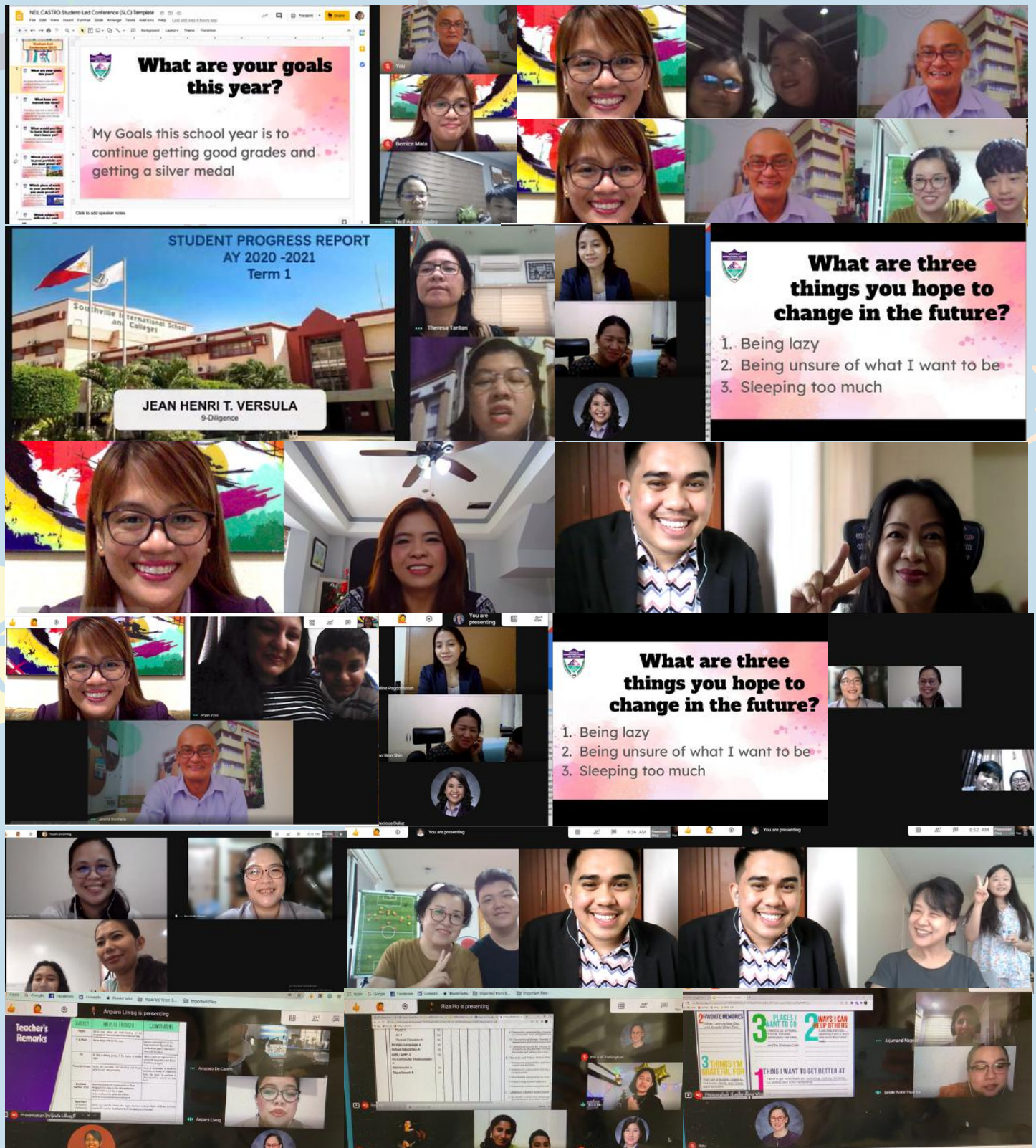

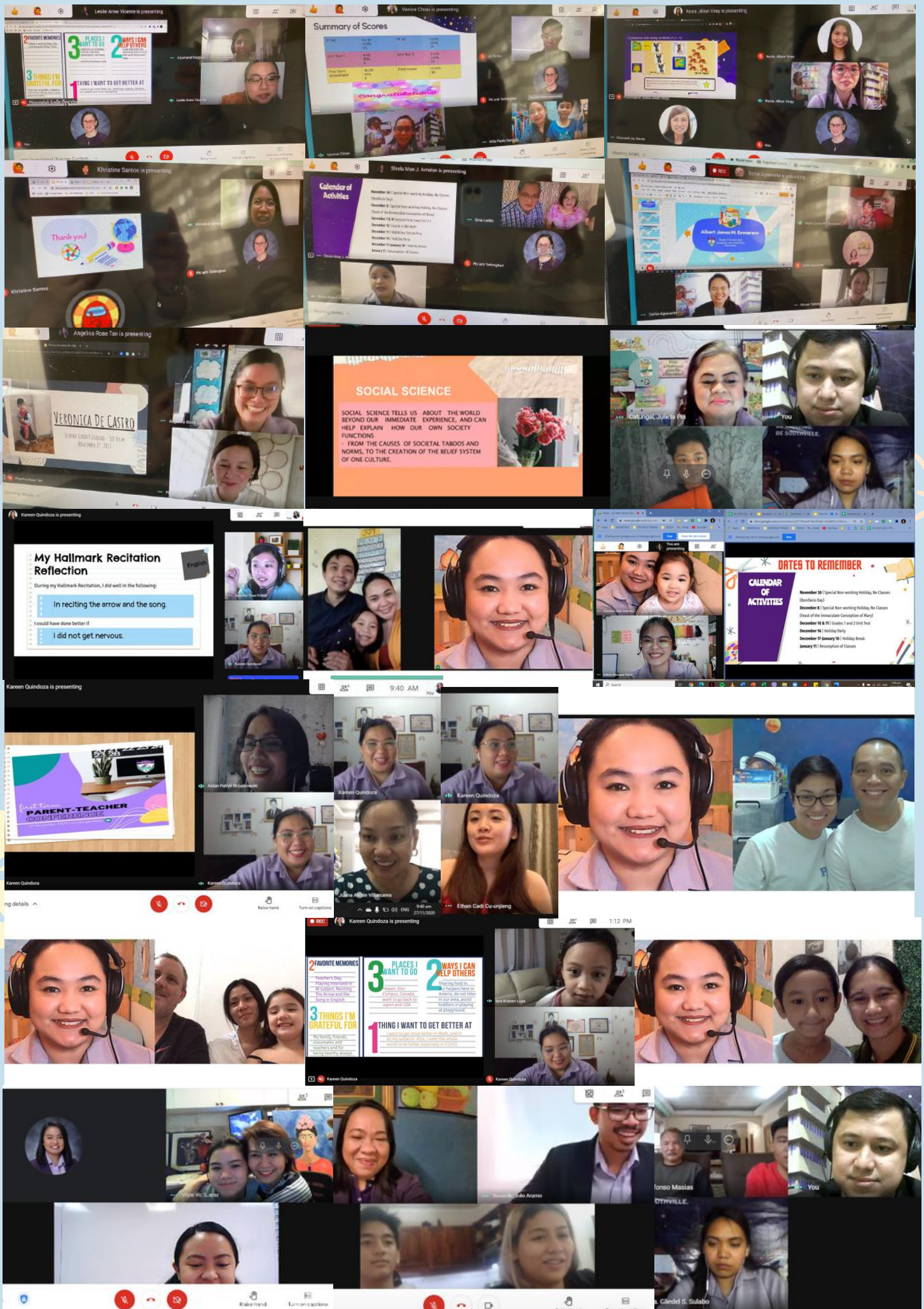

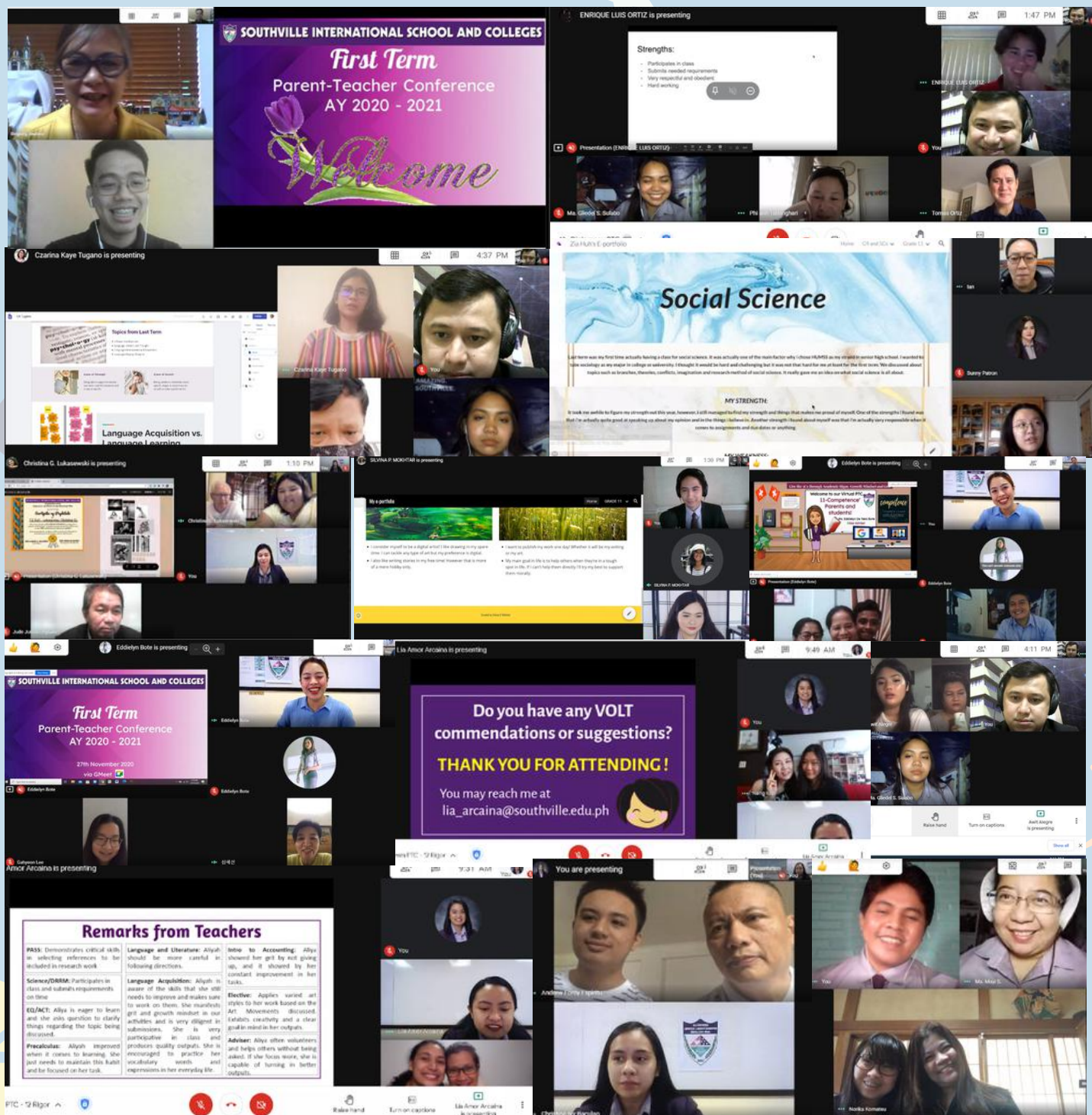


THANK YOU FOR ATTENDING THE PTC
