MONARCH WINS IN GLOBAL GEOMETRY CONTEST

A Grade 8 student from Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) took a silver medal in the 7th Iranian Geometry Olympiad. Ervin Joshua Bautista achieved the high ranking under unusual pandemic-related conditions that required participants from over 50 countries to compete virtually.

Bautista competed in the elementary (Grades 7 and 8) level, answering five geometry tests of increasing complexity within four and a half hours. Held simultaneously in different countries around the world, the annual academic contest aims to promote appreciation for geometry as one of the main branches of mathematics.
