HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS RECEIVE LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Eight members of the Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) High School Class of 2021 won scholarships here and abroad based on their individual academic performance and leadership roles in senior high school. Cuitlauzina Brianna Cerbito was awarded a full tuition and fees grant by Ateneo de Manila University while Justina Torres will receive an annual P100,000 scholarship grant from the same university.

Internationally, Kang Kim was named university scholar by the University of San Francisco while Lee Ge Jin earned scholarships from Pace University and St. John's University in New York and St. Peter's University in New Jersey. Min Sung Kim, meanwhile, received financial grants from the University of Buffalo and Stony Brook University.

In the United Kingdom, Christopher Villafuerte was offered a scholarship by the University of Brighton and Ravensbourne while Clarise Liu received a similar offer from the University of Western Australia. David Ramos, on the other hand, was selected for scholarship by the University of British Columbia - Vancouver Campus.


