



Due to the pandemic, SISC will temporarily not hold the SISCAT (Southville International School and Colleges Admission Test) for incoming Preschool – Grade 12 students, college freshmen, and transferees for academic year 2021 – 2022. However, new student applicants are still subject to further evaluation and screening by submitting the following documents:

- Photocopy of Birth Certificate
- Certificate of Good Moral Character
- Photocopy of Report Card/Transcript of Records
- Transcript of Records and Transfer Credentials (for transferees)
- Accomplished Admission Application Form

SISC offers courses in BS Accountancy, AB Mass Communications, AB Media Arts, BS Information Technology, BS Nursing, BS Psychology, BS Tourism, BS Entrepreneurship, BS Business Administration major in Financial Accounting & Management/Human Resource Management/Marketing Management, and BEED Special Education.

Southville International School affiliated with Foreign Universities (SISFU), on the other hand, offers courses in Business Management from De Montfort University, and Hospitality Management from the International College of Hotel Management while South SEED – LPDH College offers programs in BS Pharmacy, BS Medical Technology and BS Radiologic Technology.
