Monarchs win medals at global science contest



Gwyneth Margaux Tangog of IB 2 snagged a silver medal while Robert Jeremiah Rivera of Gr. 10 Commitment bagged a bronze medal in the 2021 Copernicus Natural Science, Astronomy and Physics Olympiad held through an online format last October 31, 2021. Students from more than 40 countries participated in the first round of the competition aiming to increase students' interest in science.

With their victories, Tangog and Rivera qualified for the final round of the Olympiad slated on January 7-9, 2022 at the NASA Johnson Space Station in Houston, Texas, USA.

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Who will go to extended midyear or EMY class?

Students from Grades 1-12 who will get a grade of LA (Low Average), P (Poor), or Inc (Incomplete) during the First Term, graduating students with P.A.S.S. and GEM Project deficiencies, Grades 11 and 12 students with incomplete SATs Math (Khan) mastered skills, and late enrollees with audit tutorials will have to attend the remedial class on November 29 - December 3, 2021 so they will get a better understanding of the subject and will be given time to complete their requirements.

A removal exam will then be given to students who got a grade of LA and below after the EMY to ensure that the students gain the skills necessary to succeed in their level.
