**MATH WHIZ CLINCHES GOLD IN
US COMPETITION**

A high school student from Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) won a gold medal in the American Mathematics Olympiad which took place online last November 6, 2021. Ervin Joshua Bautista of Gr. 9 - Compassion finished in the top 8% of his level in the global competition jointly developed by Southern Illinois University and the Singapore International Mastery Competition Centre.

Bautista went head-to-head with competitors from Singapore, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Brazil, Cambodia, Canada, Hongkong, Macau, China, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Iran, Japan, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, the Philippines, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Turkey, the United Arab Emirates, the United States, Uzbekistan and Vietnam to earn the honor to compete in the Singapore International Math Olympiad Challenge and in the International Junior Math Olympiad.
