## **Monarchs bag scholarships to London summer schools**

Ten high school students from Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) won scholarships to attend the Immerse Summer School in Cambridge University or University of Oxford, England. Neel Sharma of International Baccalaureate (IB) 1 won a 50% scholarship while Brielle Victoria G. Rodriguez of Gr. 9 - Compassion, Lee Ji Soo of Gr. 9 - Fortitude, John Matthew Bryan Cabiles of Gr. 10 - Commitment and Tyrulf Constantine Ekberg of IB-1 earned a 30% scholarship after submitting entries to the Immerse Education Essay Competition.

Awarded a 20% scholarship was Sofia Leigh Sindac of Gr. 11-Competence and getting a 10% scholarship were Stephanie Brown of Gr. 7 – Optimism, Kim Min Young and Lee Hajung of Gr. 9 – Compassion, and Yoeiza Garcia of Gr. 10 – Conviction. Split into age groups, the SISC scholars wrote an individual essay on their area of personal interest and used their academic writing skills to qualify for the summer academic programs of two of the top ranked universities in the world.
