SISC students get expert perspectives on Russia-Ukraine crisis

Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) organized a town hall forum on the Russia - Ukraine Crisis last March 2, 2022 to advance student knowledge about the situation. Mr. André Peter C. Estanislao of the Department of Foreign Affairs spoke to High School and International Baccalaureate students over Zoom to share his thoughts and analyses on the ongoing war between the neighboring countries.

In his talk, Estanislao tackled the current conflict through an analytical and geopolitical perspective, going through an in-depth discussion of the policies and events that led to the ongoing crisis. He also presented the official views of the Department of Foreign Affairs and the Department of National Defense through a discussion of their official statements released to the public.

The participants were grateful for the opportunity to connect and engage around a conflict halfway across the world but felt so close to home. The forum provided answers and placed in context everything about the current turmoil amidst the barrage of information and misinformation found on social media and in the news. It was an education for the next generation of leaders and movers of society to build a more peaceful future.

IB students promote gender equality through the arts



How to Stay Safe When Going Back to School

• Get vaccinated.

It is recommended that anyone age 5 years and older get a COVID-19 vaccine to help protect against the virus. The benefits of COVID-19 vaccination outweigh the known and potential risks.

Know your COVID-19 community level.

COVID-19 community levels can help community members decide what prevention steps to take based on the latest data.

• Maintain physical distance.

Keep a distance of at least 1m from one another and avoid spending time with groups in crowded places.

• Wash hands properly.

Hand washing with soap destroys the outer membrane of the virus and thereby inactivates it.

• Wear a facemask. Wearing a well-fitted mask helps protect the wearer and others from getting the COVID-19 virus.

Research has shown that the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine is 100% effective in protecting children, 12 to 15 years old, from the COVID-19 virus. For children ages 5 through 11, the vaccine is about 91% effective. The vaccine is also 91% effective in preventing severe illnesses from COVID-19 for people ages 16 and older.


