




Students embrace online PASS defense


Perceived Effect of Sleep Deprivation on Academic Performance

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




SISC undergoes internal quality audit

SISC stepped up its efforts to assure the quality of the learning opportunities provided to its students by undergoing an ISO Internal Quality Audit (IQA). The audit ensured that the school is in line with ISO 9001 which is the international standard for a quality management system. - 2. Alumni who wish to pursue their graduate studies (MBA, MIT, MA Psychology) at SISC will enjoy a discount of 10% on tuition fee for one term and 5% on the subsequent terms.
