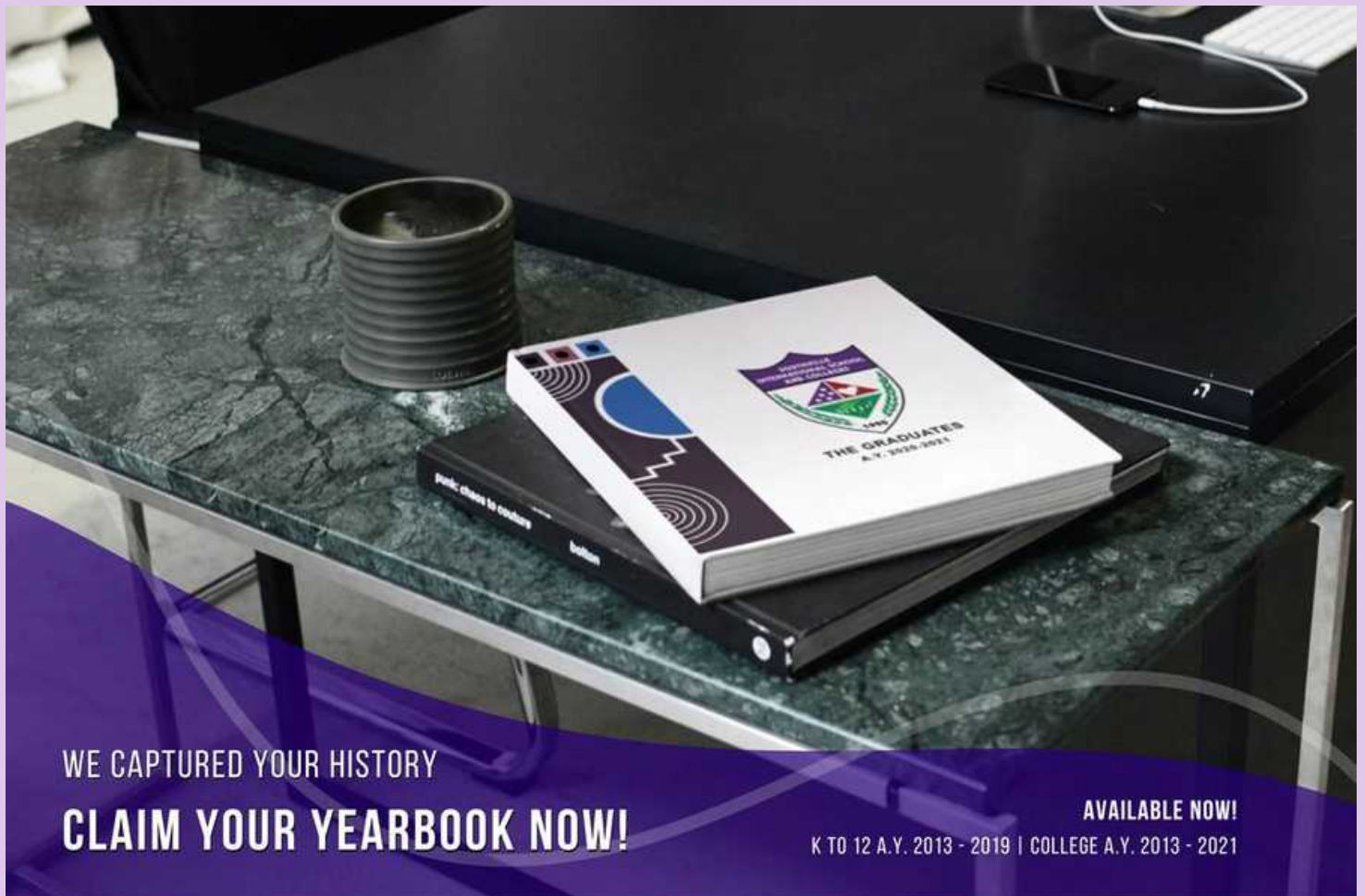

THE FOUR ASPECTS OF BODY IMAGE

Body image is the mental picture someone has on their physical body, as well as their attitude towards it. For many of us, our body image plays a role on our self-esteem and how we feel about ourselves.

1

PERCEPTUAL

This is the way you perceive yourself and your body. There could be a discrepancy with facts (underweight) and your own perception (fat).

AFFECTIVE

This is the way you feel about your body and how you look. There can be either satisfaction or dissatisfaction with your affective body image.

COGNITIVE

This is the way you think and have beliefs about your body. For example how you ideally would want your body to look (curvy, muscular, thin, etc.)

BEHAVIORAL

This is the way you act in relation to your body image, these can be acts to change your body like exercising, dieting or clothing style.
