SISC ADOPTS AWARD-WINNING LEARNING TECHNOLOGY FOR AY 2022-2023

SISC will use IXL Learning, an adaptive English, Math and Science learning platform, to support blended learning this coming academic year. The IXL platform is a personalized digital learning space that covers thousands of skills aligned with the Common Core Standards incorporated in the school curriculum. It earned top honors in the EdTech Awards for "Best E-Learning, Blended, or Flipped Learning Solution."

IXL works by offering skills that students practice, one at a time, earning them points and ribbons when they get questions correct. A student is awarded a stamp once 100 points are collected for a certain skill, and a virtual prize once multiple skills are mastered. The SmartScore goal, as it's known, helps keep students focused and working toward a target.

SISC English, Math, and Science Teachers and Subject-Area Heads have thoroughly reviewed IXL Learning, tested its alignment with the English, Math, and Science curriculums, and assessed its contribution to student achievement. Its rigorous activities help learners build a strong foundation of knowledge, understand problems in multiple contexts, and prepare themselves for higher-level thinking.
