Two more SISC students distinguished themselves in the final round of the 2022 Hong Kong International Science Olympiad held virtually around the world. Jenica Roque of Gr. 4 – Love snagged a gold medal while Nikolai Eusebio of Gr. 5 – Trustworthiness

clinched a silver medal in the competition that closely follows the Hong Kong School Science Syllabus. Roque also won in the final round of the 2022 Hong Kong International Math Olympiad participated in by countries such as Indonesia, Bulgaria, Malaysia, Myanmar, Taiwan, Thailand, Hong Kong, India, Australia, Cambodia, Vietnam, Singapore, China, and Iran. She scored 90 and above in the exam on Logical Thinking, Algebra, Number Theory, Geometry and Combinatorics to claim the silver medal.

### Global Handwashing Day

Keeping hands clean is one of the simplest and most effective ways to stop spreading germs and certain diseases. Regularly washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol-based hand sanitizer can help keep you and those around you safe and healthy.

**Global Handwashing Day** is celebrated every **15th of October** to raise awareness and understanding about the importance of hand hygiene.

#### When to wash your hand

- 1 Before, during, and after preparing food
- 2 Before you eat
- 3 After you sneeze or blow your nose
- 4 After you play or stay in a public place
- 5 After you use the bathroom

#### Other ways to stop the spread of germs

- 1 Avoid close contact with other people and crowds.
- 2 Stay home when you are sick.
- 3 Cover your mouth and nose while sneezing or coughing.
- 4 Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- 5 Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects.

### PROPER HAND WASHING



Wet hands with water.



Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.



Rub hands palm to palm



Rub the back of each hand with the palm of the other hand.



Rub palm to palm with fingers interlaced.



Rub each wrist with the opposite hand.



Rinse hands with water.



Dry your hand thoroughly.



Hand washing should take at least 20 seconds.
