Students from Grades 1-12 who will get a grade of LA (Low Average), P (Poor), or Inc (Incomplete) during the First Term will have to attend the remedial class on November 28 – December 2, 2022 so they will get a better understanding of the subject and have time to complete their requirements.

A removal exam will then be given to students who got a grade of LA and below after the EMY to ensure that they gain the skills necessary to succeed in their level.
