

# Hand- Foot -and-Mouth-Disease

Hand-foot-and-mouth disease is a mild, contagious viral infection common in young children but anyone can get it.

### Symptoms

#### Fever and flu like symptoms

Fever and other flu like symptoms appear 3-5 days after catching the virus.





#### Mouth sores

Sores usually start as small red spots often on the tongue and inside of the mouth.

#### Skin rash

The rash is prominently seen in the palms of the hands and soles of the feet but it can also show up on the buttocks, legs, and arms.



### When to see a doctor



When the child is not able to drink normally



- When the child is not alert and responsive
- When symptoms do not improve after 10 days
- When symptoms are severe
- When the child is very young, especially younger than 6 months

### **Prevention Tips**



Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces like door knobs and shared items like toys.



Avoid touching your nose, eyes and mouth with unwashed hands.



Avoid contact with sick people.


