# SISC'S RED CROSS CLUB HOLDS FIRST BLOOD DRIVE POST-PANDEMIC

Southville International School and Colleges' (SISC) Red Cross Youth (RCY) organization held a blood donation drive last February 15, 2023 to allow students and staff to donate blood to the Philippine Red Cross. The drive was held in the school's Luxembourg Hall, with multiple medical workers and student volunteers helping to take the blood of over 30 donors.

The donation drive was held in collaboration with the Red Cross Youth - Muntinlupa Chapter with the objective of boosting accessibility to the blood supply in the country and improving the health of the general public. Before the event, the officers and members of RCY - SISC promoted the event to the school community to increase awareness about the importance of donating blood due to the supply shortage brought by the pandemic.

It was an extremely successful event with 39 bags of blood donated and 58 donors able to experience first-hand the value of volunteering, community involvement, and altruism. The RCY - SISC hopes to arrange and organize more events and programs like this to learn and gain relevant experience for their future careers while developing crucial social and leadership skills.
