K12 REOPENS STATE-OF-THE-ART FINANCIAL LAB


The Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) Financial Lab welcomed back tomorrow's financial leaders to an authentic trading environment. High school students no longer have to wait until they graduate from college to experience all the excitement of the trading floor.

The center features a Technistock Financial and Investor Terminal which provides real-time stock quotes, technical charts, company research, and portfolio tools for analyzing market trends and evaluating financial data to be able to make effective investment decisions. Workstations for performing stock transactions, analyzing companies, and managing virtual and real stock portfolio will enable the students to practice wealth management and to learn what trading is like in the real world.

The lab features LED screens that display real-time market updates, stock quotes and financial news from Bloomberg, ANC, and CNN. There's also a Knowledge Resource Collection of finance and business books donated by the Bangko Sentral of the Philippines to serve as references for students and faculty.

The Financial Lab, located on the fifth floor of the High School Building on Luxembourg Campus, is part of SISC's Financial Literacy Program to familiarize students with the tools used in financial services and to develop future business leaders through innovative opportunities.

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EIGHTH GRADER WINS TITLE AT TENNIS TOURNAMENT

One of the greatest singular achievements in one's life is graduating with honors after years of diligent studying and active participation in school. To be cited on stage in front of one's peers, with one's parents or guardians proudly beaming with pride, is an unforgettable and unparalleled moment in a young person's life. For Academic Year 2022 - 2023, graduating International Baccalaureate (IB) students can look forward to this glorious moment based on the following guidelines for computing honors:

A. General Guidelines

- a. Achieved a total of 24 points at the end of year 2
- b. Received at least a grade of D in TOK and EE
- c. On-target status in CAS
- d. No grade of 2 in any subjects.
- e. No more than three grade 3s or below in both HL and SL subjects.
- f. Has gained 12 points or more on HL subjects (16 points for four HL subjects)
- g. Has gained 9 points or more on SL subjects
- h. No record of Academic malpractice

B. Awards

- a) Academic Achievement
 - i. The students should meet criteria A.
 - ii. GOLD MEDAL 39 to 45 points SILVER MEDAL - 36 to 38 points BRONZE MEDAL - 32 to 35 points

b) Subject Excellence Award

Student/s who manifested exemplary performance in the subject.

c) Loyalty Award

This is given to the student who started in SISC from 1st Grade and has not skipped a school year in SISC.
