### Colds

During the rainy season, the drastic fluctuation of temperature makes the body susceptible to bacterial and viral attack, resulting in colds and flu. Colds spread easily, especially within homes, classrooms and workplaces.



What is a cold?

A cold is a contagious upper respiratory infection that affects the nose, throat, sinuses and windpipe (trachea).



#### How to Protect Yourself

Viruses that cause colds can spread from infected people to others through the air and close personal contact. To reduce the risk of getting a cold:

Many different respiratory viruses can cause the common cold, but rhinoviruses are the most common. Rhinoviruses can also trigger asthma attacks and have been linked to sinus and ear infections.

#### How to Protect Others

If you have a cold, you should follow these tips to help prevent spreading it to other people:

- · Stay at home while you are
- Avoid close contact with others, such as hugging, kissing, or shaking hands.
- Move away from people before coughing or sneezing.
- Cough and sneeze into a tissue then throw it away, or cough and sneeze into your upper shirt sleeve, completely covering your mouth and nose.
- Wash your hands after coughing, sneezing, or blowing your nose.
- · Disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects such as doorknobs and mobile devices.

#### Lifestyle and Home Remedies

To make yourself as comfortable as possible when you have a cold:

- Drink plenty of fluids.

- Adjust your room's temperature and humidity. If the air is dry, a coolmist humidifier can help with stuffiness and coughing.
- I Use a saltwater gargle.
- Try other throat soothers like ice chips, lozenges or hard candy.
- Try saline nasal drops or sprays to keep nasal passages moist and to loosen mucus.
