Monarchs move on to science and technology finals

The Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) delegation earned a finalist spot in the Brainiac Year 2: Clash of the Sci-Tech Champs after winning in the elimination round of the prestigious team competition in Science, Math, and Research. The Junior High School team of Ayumi Febe Bedar (9-Diligence), Joshua Levi Santos (10-Commitment), and Juan Alfonso Lobien (10-Commitment) got the highest score in their level to receive the TOP 1 Best Performing School award.

The Senior High School team of Jin Jiwon (12-Grit), Kim Inseo (12-Initiative), and Ervin Joshua Bautista (IB 1), on the other hand, finished as the TOP 9 Best Performing School in their category to also advance to the cluster final round. They competed against twenty-five other private and public science high schools from Muntinlupa, Makati, Taguig, Pateros, and Las Piñas in the contest coordinated by the Department of Education – National Capital Region.


Reminders:




