SISC earns praise from visiting WASC team

Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) was visited by a team of five international educators last **April 21 - 25, 2024** as part of the re-accreditation process for the **Western Association of Schools and Colleges, (WASC)**. WASC is one of the regional accrediting associations in the United States that assure the delivery of quality education. The members of the team are all trained in the process of assessing schools, and spent the week exploring every aspect of school life at SISC.

The team gave favorable comments about SISC, observing that the school's effort to provide a quality educational program for the students is evident. The school was commended by the WASC Visiting Team for its student success initiatives like **"research-supported online education methodologies," "strong social-emotional learning support"** and **"active prioritization of student safety."**

Grade schoolers reap awards in academic and sport contests

Sixteen Munich Campus grade schoolers won in the 2024 Philippine International Mathematical Olympiad (PhIMO) heat round held last April 14th, 2024. **Subin Cho** of Grade 6 - Courage secured a gold medal, while **Ashraya Faustina** of Grade 2 - Pasteur, **Aiken Cadre Cu-Unjieng** of Grade 3 - Wisdom, **Justine Elyse Napiza** of Grade 3 - Faith, **Jenica Beatrice Roque** of Grade 5 - Loyalty, and **Nathan Vance** of Grade 5 - Honesty earned silver.

Andres Antonio Maigue of Grade 3 - Kaizen, **Yuki Togawa** and **Elmer Vicente Codilla III** of Grade 5 - Trustworthiness, **Jeheelin Lee** of Grade 6 - Courage, and **Nikolai Isaac Eusebio** of Grade 6 - Nobility brought home bronze medals.

Additionally, **Filip Milosevic**, **Zacharry Matthew Tacad**, and **Xyross Kaye Carpio** of Grade 3 - Wisdom, **Yasmin Ahmed** of Grade 3 - Peace, and **Kent Togawa** of Grade 6 - Perseverance received Merit Awards. **Danielle Lauren Hermosilla** of Grade 5 - Trustworthiness also participated. These impressive performances qualify them for the PhIMO final round in September.

Meanwhile, **Danielle Lauren Hermosilla** of Gr. 5 - Trustworthiness bagged gold in vault, silver in beam and floor, and bronze in bars in the Bangkok Gymnastics Moose Games Invitational Meet where **Savannah Peach Dela Cruz** of Gr. 6 - Nobility also placed fifth in the individual all-around event and bagged four gold medals in the following: bars, beam, floor, and vault in WAG Level 3. In fencing, **Yuki Togawa** received a bronze medal in the Alabang Fencing 1st Minime 2024 10-Under Women's Foil Category.

Senior finds winning formula for stock market



A Grade 12 student took first place in the 13th season of the **Southville Global Education Network (SGEN) Stock Trading Challenge**. **Antonio Dy of Gr. 12 - Service (ABM)** earned a 3.44 percent return from his initial investment of Php 10,000.00 in real money, to outpace other student investors from SGEN senior high schools.

The **Stock Market Challenge** gave the participants an opportunity to apply their academic learning to real-world experiences by trading stocks and shares using the **COL Financial** online platform. It aims to provide them practical experiences in researching stocks in the Philippine capital market and building the best-performing portfolio to become the next generation of financial leaders.

SISC Financial Laboratory

5F Administration Building, Luxembourg Campus



The **Financial Laboratory (FINLAB)**, located on the fifth floor of the High School Building on Luxembourg Campus, is part of **SISC's Financial Literacy Program** to immerse students with the tools used in financial services and to **develop future business leaders** through innovative opportunities. It welcomes high school students to an authentic trading environment, so they don't have to wait until they graduate from college to experience all the excitement of the trading floor.



The **center features a Technistock Financial and Investor Terminal** which provides real-time stock quotes, technical charts, company research, and portfolio tools for analyzing market trends and evaluating financial data to be able to make effective investment decisions. Workstations for performing stock transactions, analyzing companies, and managing virtual and real stock portfolios enable the students to practice wealth management and to learn what trading is like in the real world.



They actively apply their stock trading skills in this dynamic setting using a virtual trading platform (**Investagrams**) and an actual online trading platform (**COL Financial**). The lab features LED screens that display real-time market updates, stock quotes and financial news from Bloomberg, ANC, and CNN. There's also a Knowledge Resource Collection of finance and business books donated by the Bangko Sentral of the Philippines to serve as references for students and faculty.

The **Rotary Club of Makati Salcedo's** generous donation of PHP 500,000 as “play money” underscores their dedication to nurturing the next generation of leaders and entrepreneurs, while the SGEN Schools provide the platform and resources necessary to facilitate the challenge. Together, they create an enriching environment where students can thrive, learn, and grow.

Students further elevate their learning experience by engaging in collaborative brainstorming sessions within the Financial Laboratory, where they actively participate in the creation and development of their business plans. This immersive approach not only enhances their understanding of financial concepts but also cultivates a dynamic environment that encourages creative thinking and strategic planning among the students.
