## Math whiz lands spot on national team

An **International Baccalaureate (IB)** student from **Southville International School and Colleges (SISC)** earned a spot in the 6-member Philippine team that will compete in the **65th International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO)** to be held in Bath, United Kingdom on **July 11 – 22, 2024**. **Ervin Joshua Bautista** of IB-1 will represent the country in the largest and most prestigious international olympiad that brings together the **brightest young minds** from a hundred countries around the world.

**Bautista** was chosen after distinguishing himself in the **Mathematical Olympiad Summer Camp** that invited the 30 national finalists of the **Philippine Mathematical Olympiad** along with other promising mathletes.

The **SISC** Luxembourg Hall was filled with intellectual energy as the first-ever **SGEN Debate Cup** unfolded on **May 9, 2024**, bringing together talented debaters from four esteemed SGEN schools: **Southville International School and Colleges (SISC)**, **South Mansfield College (SMC)**, **Stonyhurst Southville International School Malarayat (SSISM)**, and **Stonyhurst Southville International School Malarayat Batangas (SSISB)**.

With the theme ***"Scaling Global Borders: Tackling Transnational Issues for Change,"*** the SGEN Debate Cup aims to deepen students' understanding of public speaking with **collaboration** and **commitment** and further the skills of debaters through a fierce battle of wit and logic.



This historic event, the first debate cup held onsite, marked another significant milestone for the participants of the debate cup from various SGEN schools, fostering friendly competition and intellectual exchange among their students. After a series of intense elimination rounds, only two teams per division advanced to the final debate match - SISC and SMC for Junior High and SISC and SSISM for Senior High School.

In a display of exceptional debate prowess, the champions emerged - all hailing from the host campus. Mattea Barabara Moreno, Shin Hyeyeon, and Joshua Levi Santos dominated the Junior High School category, and the Senior High School championship was secured by the team of Daniel Benileo Baniqued, Sophia Helena Carpio, and Kim Kimoon. Joshua Levi Santos was also given a citation as Best Speaker in the High School division. The final matches were honorably adjudicated by seasoned debaters Mr. Carlo Concepcion and Mr. Jeanrick Nuñez.

SISC's double victory is a testament to the school's commitment in promoting a culture of critical thinking and effective communication. The rigorous academic programs and emphasis on debate equip students with the tools they need to excel in competitive environments.

The SGEN Debate Cup proved to be a resounding success, solidifying SGEN's dedication to academic excellence and collaboration. The fierce but friendly competition served as a valuable learning experience for all participants, strengthening intellectual growth and camaraderie.

# Enroll early to save and ensure slot for next school year

SISC is open for enrollment for academic year 2024-2025, offering face-to-face or hybrid learning, and fully online classes. Enrolling early allows students to lock-in their slot especially for in-person classes that will limit the number of students in the classroom. 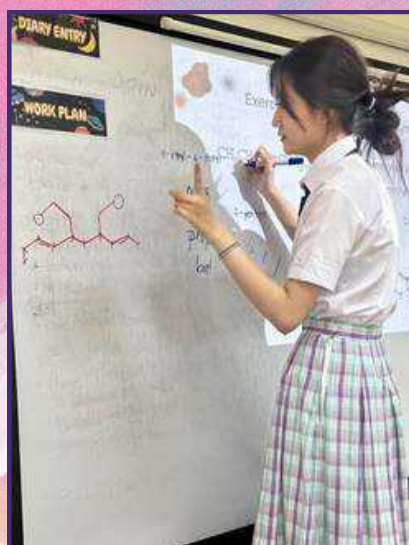
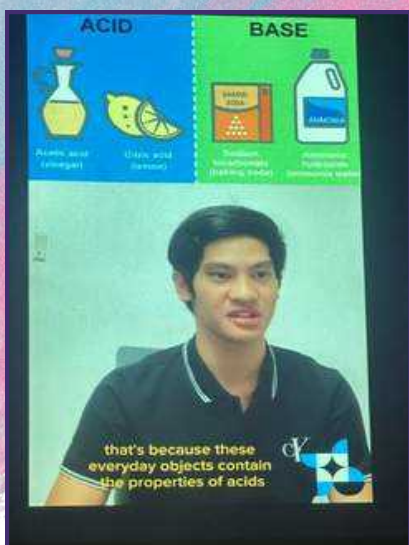
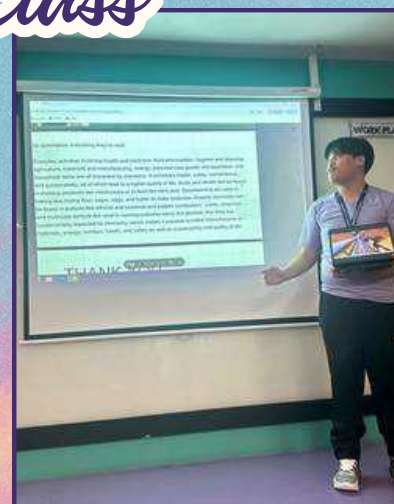
