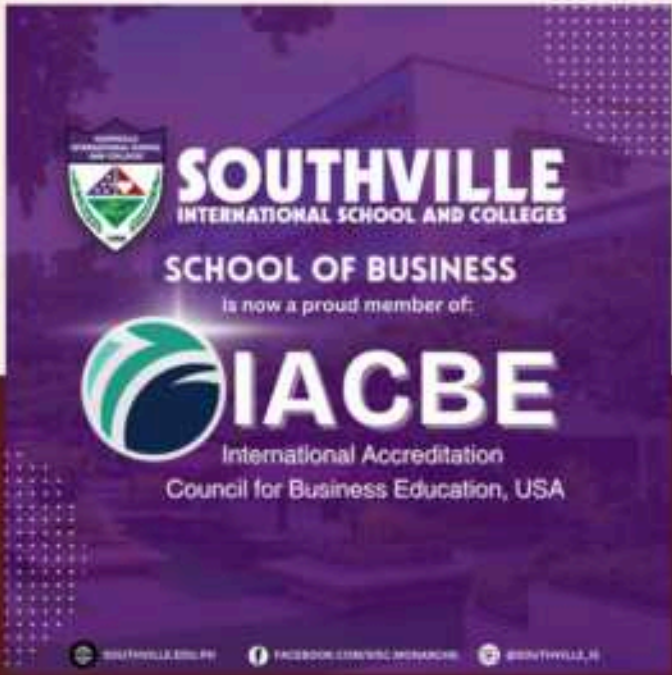

Hordeolum (Stye)



What is Hordeolum (Stye)?

It is a painful or tender red bump on the edge of the eyelid. It can look similar to an acne pimple, and it forms when a tiny oil-producing gland in the eyelash follicle or eyelid skin becomes blocked and a bacterial infection develops. It generally is not contagious.

What causes a Stye?

A stye occurs when a gland on the edge of the eyelid becomes infected. When it occurs inside or under the eyelid, it's called an internal hordeolum.

Staph (Staphylococcus aureus) is the most common bacteria or germ that causes the infection.

Internal Styes

Types of Stye



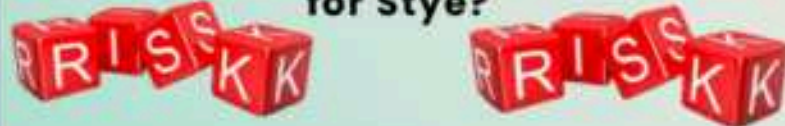
Form on the outer edge of the upper or lower eyelid and are the most common type; an infection in the eyelash follicle generally causes it

External Styes

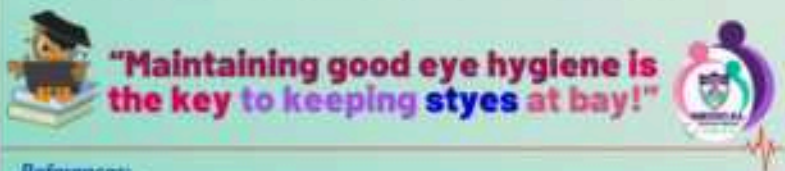


Develop on either of the inner eyelids (facing the eyeball) and is caused by an infection in the inner eyelid gland, which produces oil to keep the eyelids moist.

Who is at risk for Stye?



- Have had a stye before
- Wear contact lenses
- Have blepharitis (an inflammation of the eyelids)
- Have high lipid levels ("bad" cholesterol)

Hordeolum (Stye)



Symptoms



Eyelid swelling, redness, pain or soreness



Feeling like there is something in the eye



Eye tearing or crusting



Light sensitivity



Eye discharge

Treatment

Use warm compress for at least 5-10 minutes at 3-5 times a day.

Clean eyelids by gently wiping away discharge with a mild soapy solution.

Use lubricating eye drops or ointments designed for stye relief, as directed by a pharmacist or doctor.

Prevention Tips:

Maintain good eye hygiene by washing face and eyelids daily.

Remove makeup thoroughly before sleeping.

Replace eye makeup regularly to avoid bacterial buildup.



When to call a doctor



If the stye doesn't improve within a few days, causes severe pain or affects your vision, seek medical advice.
