# 5 WAYS TO FOSTER INNOVATION IN YOUR + CHILD



Encourage your child's correctly by modeling thoughtful questions out loud and guiding them to write down their own questions for later exploration.





To help your child develop critical thinking, alk openended questions that begin with 'why,' 'hew,' where,' or 'when,' and model this habit by doing the same in your own decision-making.





To norture creative thinking and innovation, encourage your child to take healthy risk, reframe fears of failure with positive possibilities, and adopt empowering family mantrai like "if we don't try, we won't know."



Encourage innovation by resisting the urge to overmodel, and instead give young children the freedom to explore, experiment, and find their own ways of using resources and completing talks. Provide a purpose



Inspire your child? creativity by involving them in real challenges or problems, al innovation often thrives when there's a clear and meaningful purpose behind their thinking.

# SCOLIOSIS

is a sideways curvature of the spine that occurs most often during the growth spurt just before puberty. About 3% of adolescents have scoliosis.



Most cases of scoliosis are mild, but some spine deformities continue to get more severe as children grow.

## , Types of Scoliosis

Idiopathic scoliosis This is the most common type. "Idiopathic" means the cause is unknown.

Congenital scoliosis This when the spine curves to the side. This condition may be present at birth but may also develop later in life.

Neuromuscular scolloals This is a form of scollosis that affects the muscle and nerves in the spine. It usually occurs in children ages 10-15 but can affect adults as well.

### Symptoms of Scoliosis



## ? Causes of Scoliosis

Scoliosis appears to involve hereditary factors and may be caused by:

- Neuromuscular conditions, such as cerebral palsy or muscular dystrophy
- Birth defects affecting the development of the bones of the spine
- Injuries to or infections of the spine

## S Treatment

#### Braces

One of the option is to wear a brace on the back or chest to support the spine and stop it from curving any further

#### Surgery

Surgery for scoliosis can be a good option, but not for everyone. Most of the patients who receive surgery do so because their curves are so severe that they cannot be treated with physical therapy or bracing.

### Physical Therapy

A physical therapist can help restore proper muscle balance and strengthen the muscles around the spine. Exercises also help keep the back strong and flexible
