## Acid Reflux, Heartburn, GERD. What's the difference?

The terms acid reflux, heartburn and GERD are often used interchangeably.

However, they actually have different meanings:

- **Acid Reflux** - is a common condition where stomach acid travels back up your esophagus.
- **Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD)** - is the chronic, more severe form of acid reflux.
- **Heartburn** - is a symptom of acid reflux and GERD.

## Prevalence

Acid reflux is a common experience among many Filipinos, with a 2023 report identifying it among the top three digestive concerns for Filipinos. As early as 2014, the Philippine Society of Gastroenterology (PSG) even made treatment guidelines for gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) due to its growing prevalence in the country.
