From the beginning, the SISC IB Programme has consistently delivered results above the world average. This achievement reflects not just academic excellence but also the character and commitment of our Monarchs, who approach challenges with resilience, integrity, and a passion for lifelong learning.

In the last academic year, our students reached new heights as two Monarchs distinguished themselves among the top IB achievers worldwide, scoring 44/45 and 43/45—outcomes that highlight their competence and intellectual discipline.

What's Strong:


- Students feel safe and secure in school.

STUDENTS TO TAKE SBA PRETEST

Students from preschool to high school will take the Standards-Based Assessment (SBA) Pre-Test from September 22-23, 2025 to get a profile of where they are in English, Science and Math. The tests will also show to the school the specific areas to work on to ensure that all learners will meet the standards for success.

Developed by the Asian Psychological Services and Assessment, the SBA test measures student achievement and competencies in the core subject areas: English Language Arts (Reading, Writing, and Media) Mathematics (Numbers and Number Sense Operations, Measurement, Patterns and Algebra, Geometry, Statistics and Probability) and Science (Earth and Space, Life Science, Physical Science, and Nature of Science).

With standards-based assessment, students, teachers, parents, and school administrators will get the following BENEFITS:

- The SBA provides good feedback to the student on how well he/she has learned and the degree of his/her readiness to move to a higher educational level.
- The SBA pinpoints competencies of students and learning gaps which serve as bases for learning reinforcement or remediation.







• The SBA will determine the performance of SISC students against school, national and international norms.

Results of the assessment can also aid teachers and the school to identify the areas of strengths and developmental areas which consequently can provide information for improvement of the institution's curriculum. Furthermore, the SBA provides an objective and relevant feedback to the school in terms of its quality and effectiveness of instruction against national norms and international standards.



HIGH SCHOOL PARTNERS WITH JAPANESE TECH FIRM TO STRENGTHEN STEM PROGRAM

SISC has entered into an agreement with Focus Systems Corporation of Japan, aimed at elevating its High School STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and



Mathematics) program through cutting-edge technology and expert collaboration.

This strategic alliance will empower Southville students with advanced tools, innovative learning opportunities, and mentorship from global technology experts, preparing them to excel in the fast-evolving fields of science, research, and innovation.

Through the partnership, SISC high school students will gain access to real-world applications of STEM, including hands-on training in emerging technologies, research-based projects, and collaborative learning experiences with Japanese professionals. The initiative also supports SISC's mission to nurture globally competitive learners who are future-ready and capable of addressing challenges through creativity, critical thinking, and innovation.

"This partnership is a bold step toward strengthening our STEM program," said our High School Deputy Principal and Academic Technology & Special Programs Officer Ms. Nessie Lumbres. "By working with Focus Systems Corporation, we are giving our students the chance to learn from industry leaders and engage with cutting-edge technology, ensuring they are well-prepared for future careers in science and innovation."

The partnership underscores Southville's continued efforts to expand its international network and provide meaningful opportunities for its students, aligning with its 35-year tradition of academic excellence and global education.


