



With just seven minutes left on the clock, Collen scored the decisive goal that sealed the championship—an incredible repeat of last year's victory, where she netted both goals in a 2–1 win against the same team from San Carlos.

This year's tournament brought together 34 highly competitive teams from across the country, with every match in the quarterfinals and semifinals proving to be intense and closely fought. Despite being one of the youngest players in the tournament, Collen stood out not only for her scoring prowess but also for her stellar defense—successfully shutting down the tournament's top scorer in the finals.


