
We are proud to announce the qualifiers and winners of the International Math and Science Olympiad (IMSO) and the International Smart Student Olympiad (ISSO).

A CLEAN SWEEP AT THE INTERNATIONAL SMART STUDENT OLYMPIAD (ISSO)



PRACTICE THE "2-MINUTE CLEANUP RULE"

If a task takes 2 minutes or less such as throwing trash away, arranging books, etc., do it immediately. Small actions prevent clutter from building up.

SORT BEFORE YOU STORE

Arrange items into simple categories: **keep, store, recycle,** or **throw away**

IDENTIFY "MESS SPOTS"

Notice areas that get messy quickly. Check and clean these areas (study table, bag, etc.) daily to prevent bigger problems later.
