As Southville International School and Colleges (SISC) proudly celebrates its 35th year, we look back with gratitude and pride on a journey filled with milestones, memories, and graduates who have soared to great heights. From our current K-12 students to our alumni who now thrive in the world's most prestigious universities, Southville's story is one of perseverance, excellence, and character.

35 Years, Countless Achievements

Over the decades, our graduates have entered top-ranked universities worldwide including Harvard University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Imperial College London, London School of Economics, National University of Singapore, Seoul National University, and the United States Military Academy at West Point, plus other leading institutions across the US, UK, Europe, and Asia. Their success is a living testament to the strength of Southville's academic foundation and values-driven education.

Yet, one doesn't need to look far to find world-class opportunities. SISC's College Division continues to make its mark globally, ranking within the Top 1% in the Philippines and Top 2% across Asia in the AppliedHE Public & Private University Rankings 2026, and placing in the Top 1% worldwide in the World University Rankings for Innovation (WURI) 2025.

These achievements affirm that Southville is not only a gateway to the world but also a premier destination for higher learning right here at home.

ACHIEVEMENTS FOR AY 2025-2026 (1ST QUARTER)

The first part of the current academic year was marked by exceptional distinctions, highlighted by the stellar achievements of the International Baccalaureate (IB) Class of 2025, which surpassed global standards with a remarkable 34.0 mean score and produced three world-class topnotchers, each scoring 43 to 44 out of 45 points. Further elevating these academic successes, SISC was recognized as the Most Outstanding and Top Performing School by the Math Olympiad Technology League Inc., with IB student Ervin Joshua Bautista once again earning a place on the Philippine team for the International Mathematical Olympiad. Rounding off an extraordinary quarter, Southville students achieved a 100% win rate at the Brent Model United Nations (BMUN) 2025, securing top awards across all committees and reinforcing the school’s reputation for excellence in diplomacy, critical thinking, and global citizenship.

MINIMAL TUITION FEE ADJUSTMENT

We understand the financial considerations of our families. That’s why, for AY 2026-2027, we have kept the tuition fee increase to a minimal 3%. This allows us to continue providing high-quality education, enriched programs, and improved facilities while remaining mindful of our community’s needs.

In this regard, kindly fill out this online early enrollment reservation form and send to this email address as soon as possible.

Preschool, Grade School, and High School students who have fully paid their accounts, have no academic deficiency, and have no discipline issues can already reserve a slot for Academic Year 2026-2027.

A. Early Enrollment:

There will be an early enrollment discount for students who will enroll from April 7, 2026 to June 30, 2026. A separate bulletin will be released for our guidelines.

B. Alumni’s Dependent/s Discount

For newly enrolled alumni dependents, a discount of P5,000 in the 1st year of enrollment and P3,000 in the succeeding years will be given.

An entry level discount of P5,500 will apply to SISC graduates enrolling in Grade 1, Grade 7, and Grade 11.



How can I keep my **heart** healthy?




Achieve and maintain a weight that's healthy for you.
